Presidential Management Fellows (PMF) Program

www.pmf.opm.gov/Index.aspx

The PMF Program is a two-year paid federal government fellowship sponsored by the Office of Personnel Management for graduate students from various academic

disciplines. Applicants may apply to the PMF Program *only* during the academic year they will complete their degree requirements (master's, law, or doctoral-level). *Generally, applicants are permitted to apply for the PMF program only once per graduate degree.* Check the website for application information and deadlines.
