

Study at ABA Approved Law Schools

King Hall Exchange Program- China, Copenhagen and Dublin

Law students have the opportunity to study at another ABA approved law school and participate in the King Hall Exchange Program in China, Copenhagen and Dublin. Interested students must contact the Law Registrar and obtain approval of the Assistant Dean of Student Affairs to participate in and receive financial aid for a study away program.

Study Away through an ABA Approved Law School's Study Abroad Program	<p>Summer and Academic Year Financial Aid is not available from UC Davis. Apply for financial aid through the host ABA Approved Law School.</p>
Financial aid is not available to cover the cost to enroll in UC Davis non-law courses during the summer.	

How to Apply for Financial Aid for Study Away Programs

- File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid - FAFSA by March 2.
- Obtain permission to study at another ABA approved law school from the UC Davis Law Registrar and Assistant Dean of Student Affairs.
- Obtain a Visiting Student Agreement (VSA) on-line at www.law.ucdavis.edu/current/financial-aid/index.html under 'Downloadable Forms.' The Financial Aid Office at the host institution should complete and return the VSA to the UC Davis Law Financial Aid Office.
- In order to receive financial aid in a timely manner, submit the Visiting Student Agreement to the UC Davis Law Financial Aid Office by:

Summer Study: May 1
 Fall Semester Study: July 30
 Spring Semester Study: November 30

- Law students approved for study at another ABA approved law school or the King Hall Exchange Program are required to sign up for Direct Deposit at studentaccounting.ucdavis.edu/directdep.cfm.
- In order to defer education loan repayment, law students must have the host school Registrar confirm enrollment for the study away period using your lender's loan deferment form.
