Education Abroad

King Hall Foreign Exchange Program- Dublin/Copenhagen

Law students have the opportunity to study at another ABA approved law school, participate in the UC Davis Education Abroad Program (UCEAP) or the King Hall Foreign Exchange Program in Dublin or Copenhagen. Interested students should contact the Law Registrar and obtain approval of the Assistant Dean of Student Affairs for courses to be transferred back to the UC Davis School of Law. **Financial aid is not available for UC Davis non-law courses taken during the summer.**

Study Away Program Description	Aid Available for Study Away
Domestic Study @ an ABA Approved Law School	Summer: Private Loan is available from UC Davis. Academic Year: Ford Federal Direct Loan and Private Loan are available from UC Davis.
Study Abroad through an ABA Approved Law School	Summer and Academic Year: Financial Aid is not available from UC Davis. Apply for financial aid through the host school.
UCEAP - UC Education Abroad Program	Academic Year: Law Grant, Federal Perkins Loan, Ford Federal Direct Loan and Private Loan are available from UC Davis.
King Hall Foreign Exchange Program- Dublin and Copenhagen	Summer: Private Loan is available from UC Davis. Academic Year: Law Grant, Federal Perkins Loan, Ford Federal Direct Loan and Private Loan are available from UC Davis.

How to apply for financial aid for study away programs:

- Obtain permission to study at another ABA approved law school from the UC Davis Law Registrar and Assistant Dean of Student Affairs.
- Submit a Course Approval Form signed by the Assistant Dean for Student Affairs to the UC Davis Law Financial Aid Office.
- Obtain a Visiting Student Agreement (VSA) on-line at www.law.ucdavis.edu under 'Download Forms.' The Financial Aid Office at the "Host" institution should complete and return the VSA to the UC Davis Law Financial Aid Office.
- Law students approved for study at another ABA approved law school, UCEAP or the King Hall Foreign Exchange Program are **required** to sign up for Direct Deposit at studentaccounting.ucdavis.edu/directdep.cfm.
- Law students should have the **host school Registrar confirm enrollment for the study away period** using your lender's loan deferment forms.



- In order to receive aid in a timely manner, submit the VSA and Course Approval Form to the UC Davis Law Financial Aid Office by:

Fall Semester Study	July 30
Spring Semester Study	November 30
