

How to use LegalTrac

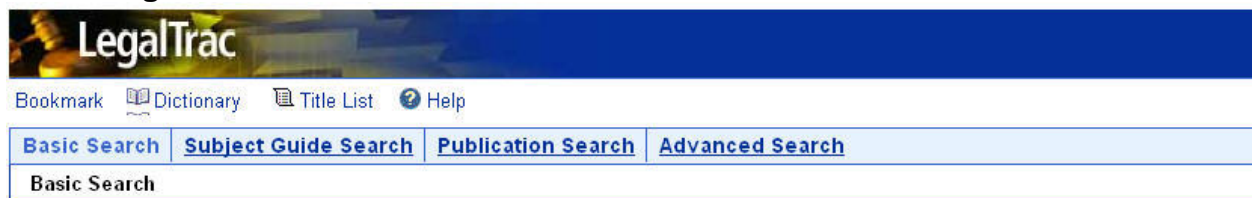
LegalTrac will give you citations to articles on a particular law-related subject, statute, or case. The database searches legal journals as well as law-related stories from business and general interest publications published after 1980.

Access

1. Go to the library's home page at www.law.ucdavis.edu/library
2. Click on "LegalTrac" under the heading "Research sites"
3. Click "proceed"

If you are accessing from off-campus, you will need to sign on to the school's [Virtual Private Network](#) (VPN) using your law school profile information.

Tips:

- An asterisk (*) will find any word that begins with the letters you entered. For example, constitut* will retrieve constitution, constitutional, constitutionalism, etc.
- To search for words as a phrase, put quotation marks around them
- Using "advanced search" instead of "basic search" will allow you to specify particular fields to be searched (e.g. author) so the hits you get will be closer to what you want
