

Bert Mason is Professor Emeritus of Agricultural Economics at CSU, Fresno. During his 27 years as a faculty member at CSU, Fresno, he served as professor, department chair, and director of the Center for Agricultural Business. The primary focus of his teaching and research was in the areas of farm labor, agricultural personnel management, and immigration policy. He was appointed as a board member of the Agricultural Labor Relations Board in 1999 by Governor Davis and served on the Board until 2002. He returned to CSUF in 2002 and retired in 2010. He was again appointed as a board member of the ALRB in January 2012 and served in this capacity until December 30, 2013.
